This party is pot luck style so bring your favorite dish that feeds 8 people and plan to attend.

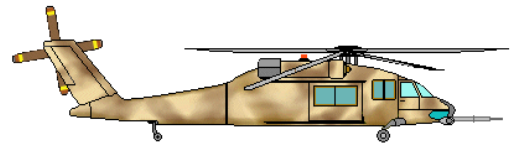

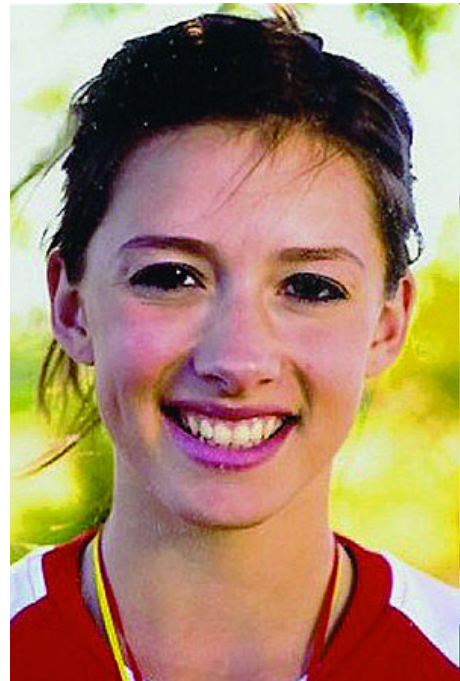
